## **SUMMER COLLEGE INTERN PROGRAM**

The BCPO sponsors an intern program for college students. Students typically work two days per week in one of the following sections: Trial, Domestic Violence, Juvenile, Narcotics Task Force, White Collar Crimes Unit, Special Victims/Megan's Law and Civil Forfeiture. College interns have the opportunity to watch court proceedings and to attend a series of lectures presented by various BCPO Units, such as the Homicide Unit, Juvenile Unit, Gang Unit and Computer Crimes Unit. The program also includes a tour of the Bergen County Jail, if scheduling permits, the Medical Examiner's Office and the opportunity to meet with judges assigned to the Superior Court, Law Division and Criminal Part.

**The deadline for applying for the Summer College Intern Program is February 20th. Applications should include a cover letter and resume.**

## **SUMMER LAW STUDENT INTERN PROGRAM**

The BCPO hires second and third year law students to work full-time during the summer. Law interns are assigned to the Appellate and Law Section, located in the Bergen County Justice Center, where their primary responsibilities are preparing the State's responding briefs in municipal appeals. Interns who are entering the third year of law school will argue these matters before the Law Division in the presence of a supervising attorney. Additionally, interns may prepare Appellate Division briefs as well as assist trial attorneys by preparing the State's brief in motions to suppress and other trial related matters. Interns have ample opportunity to observe criminal matters from arraignment to sentencing. On occasion, interns might handle bail and sentencing hearings.

**The deadline for applying for the Summer Law Student Intern Program is February 20th. Applications should include a cover letter, resume and writing sample.**

## **BCPO LAW CHAIR PROGRAM**

The BCPO has dedicated a seat in its summer law intern program to a student from each of the following area law schools: Seton Hall, Rutgers (Newark) and New York Law School. Students apply for these Law Chair positions through the Career Services Offices at their respective schools. The selection process takes place early in the Fall Semester.

## **CYBERSECURITY LAW INTERN**

In conjunction with the Cybersecurity Law Programs that it sponsors at Seton Hall and Rutgers (Newark) Law Schools, the BCPO will assign a qualified intern to assist with assignments from the Computer Crimes Unit as needed.
