"DON'T STAND BY FOR BULLYING" CONTEST

Bergen County Prosecutor John L. Molinelli announces an educational contest for all students in the county.

CONCEPT: Students today have become more aware of bullying issues, and should know that there are consequences for everyone involved: the bully, the victim, as well as the bystander. But bullying is less likely to occur in an environment that doesn't tolerate it. We are reaching out directly to Bergen County students to hear their ideas on how to combat bullying.

THEME: In their own way (through art, or graphics, or video & audio), students should describe:
HOW THEY WON'T JUST STAND BY AND LET BULLYING HAPPEN.

There are 3 categories of entries:

Grade school entries: poster contest (Student's original artwork may be submitted on poster paper – minimum size: 8 ½" x 11", maximum size: 18" x 24").

Middle school entries: Powerpoint presentation consisting of a maximum of 20 slides– to be submitted on CD, DVD or USB flash drive.

High school entries: 30 to 60 second videos – to be submitted on CD, DVD or USB flash drive.

Entries must be the original work of the student, and will be judged for creativity and the message conveyed in the submission.

CONTEST IS OPEN TO ALL STUDENTS IN ALL ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE, IN BERGEN COUNTY.

DEADLINE: All entries must be received by April 1, 2011.

Entries can be mailed or delivered to: Bergen County Prosecutor's Office, Community Outreach Office, Bergen County Justice Center, 10 Main Street, Room 207, Hackensack, NJ 07601. A completed entry/release form must accompany each entry. Entries should not include copyrighted images or music.

Winning entries will be featured at the annual Bergen County Prosecutor's Office SNAP conference on April 27 and on the BCPO website: www.bcpo.net, and will receive a Certificate of Merit.
