Employment Opportunity: Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Coordinator

Position Overview

The **SANE Coordinator** plays a critical leadership role in ensuring high-quality, trauma-informed forensic medical care for victims of sexual assault. This position oversees and supports forensic examinations, ensures compliance with state standards, and serves as a key representative of the Prosecutor's Office in matters involving sexual assault response and victim services.

Minimum Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Graduate of an accredited school of professional nursing recognized by the New Jersey Board of Nursing
- Minimum of **three (3) years of nursing experience** in one or more of the following areas:
 - Emergency Medicine
 - Women's Health
 - Critical Care
- Valid license as a Professional Nurse issued by the New Jersey Board of Nursing
- Successful completion of an approved **Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE)** training program
- Valid **Forensic Nurse – Certified Sexual Assault (FN-CSA)** specialty certificate issued by the New Jersey Board of Nursing
- Strong knowledge of nursing principles and practices necessary to assess and respond to the needs of sexual assault victims
- Ability to conduct and supervise physical and forensic examinations
- Working knowledge of the Attorney General's Standards for Providing Services to Victims of Sexual Assault
- Ability to represent the Prosecutor's Office in matters of compliance and professional coordination
- Experience providing health counseling and education to patients, families, and community groups
- Successful completion of a comprehensive employment background investigation
